

Trails Committee Report July 2nd, 2013

To date the Trails committee has held two workshops to discuss how to enhance, promote and further develop our section of rails to trails.

Our discussions have led up to develop some short term and long range goals for the trail.

Short Term

- Work with the Stockbridge Community Pathways group to promote the trails within our community and to share recourses such in the way of volunteers to help with each other's projects.
- To conduct volunteer cleanup projects along the trail to further enhance our trail. A clean up was conducted on Saturday June 1st at 10am in which low lining limbs and brush was cut to open up the trail and to make it more conducive for people riding horses. Sense Then weeds have been trimmed and mowed to clear grass and weeds back away from the trail.
- Place trash bins along the trail to hopefully reduce trash along the trail
- We have come up with a list of items we would like to see along the trail such as:

1. Signs	(1)	1,000.00
2. Dog waste dispensers	(2)	480.00
3. Benches	(4)	2,800
4. Picnic Tables	(6)	4,800
5. Trash receptacles	(3)	1,500
- Work with the DNR to develop a grant proposal for Passport Grant
